- Confirm that you have either bred or, in the case of purchased heifers, can access the required breeding information for the export cattle undergoing ACGEA certification from the single sire or multiple sire groups listed in section 2.
- Confirm that all sires listed in section 2 were in your ownership/or the ownership of the original breeder at the time of joining to produce the export cattle, or were from AI or leased sires. (**Note:** Validation checks on sire ownership or leasing status will be undertaken by the Breed Society to confirm this).
- Confirm that all sires comply with the ACGEA Standards (e.g. 3 generations of pedigree, registered in the appropriate breed society registry).
- Request that, once ownership is validated, the sire(s) be transferred into your ownership on the Breed Society database if not already done and if required by the Breed Society. In the case of multiple sires groups, a group with a specific society ID will be created by the Breed Society and provided to the Exporter.
- Request that single sire or multiple sire group be used to record the export cattle in the Breed Societies commercial register for ACGEA certification purposes.
