- a. Tuberculosis, scrapie, anaplasmosis, sarcoptic mange and scab for the past 5 years.
 - b. Muscosal disease, border disease (with clinical signs of hairy shaker syndrome), Johne’s disease, Rift Valley fever, Chlamydia and Akabane for the past 2 years.
4. The sheep have been kept isolated from other animals on the property from the start of on-farm testing until delivery to quarantine.
 5. The sheep to be exported are registered on the NLIS database against the Property Identification Code (PIC) provided above.
 6. The property of origin is in a state where ovine foot rot is a notifiable disease and there has not been a case of foot rot on the property for two years.

I give permission for the State veterinary authority to disclose to Integrity Australia the property disease information required for the export of breeding sheep to China.

I,(PRINT NAME), the owner of the sheep listed below and presented for export to China, declare that to the best of my knowledge:

1. The animals for export were derived from the nominated property that is an area, of 100 kilometers radius of the farm of origin, which has been free from clinical signs of bluetongue for the past 2 years.
2. The sheep were born on the property and have remained on the property since birth or for the last **six months**.
3. The farm of origin has been free from Brucellosis for three years and has had no clinical signs of:
